Mr. Joseph Reilly has experience since 1993 in the drug and alcohol testing industry. He regularly provides expert witness testimony, consulting and training programs for employers, collectors, TPA's, Labs and others in the drug testing industry. Currently Joe continues his consulting and training work, serves as President and CEO of National Drug Screening and serves on the Board of Directors of the Drug & Alcohol Testing Industry Association (DATIA). Joe also serves as the Senior Compliance Officer for USA Mobile Drug Testing a national franchise system of mobile collectors and compliance specialists.

Known throughout the United States as an expert in the drug testing industry, Joe has served as an expert witness and has provided consulting, speaking engagements and training programs for many organizations including the US Small Business Administration (SBA), the White House Office of National Drug Control Policy (ONDCP), the US Department of Education, the Society for Human Resource Management (SHRM), the Washington DC Department of Public Works, the Florida Office of Drug Control, the Florida Department of Corrections, the Drug & Alcohol Testing Industry Association (DATIA), the National Association of Professional Background Screeners (MAPBS), Florida Small Business Development Centers (SBDC), and numerous Chambers of Commerce.

Joe started in the drug testing business as President of Florida Drug Screening a nationwide provider of drug testing services later to be renamed Drug Testing USA. In 1997, Florida Drug Screening, Inc. was one of the first drug testing collection facilities in the nation to become accredited by DATIA. To obtain accredited status, facilities are required to adhere to strict standards in areas such as regulatory compliance, company services standards, specimen handling, operational practices, business ethics, and facility equipment.

In March of 2002, Florida Drug Screening became Nationally Accredited for Administration of Drug and Alcohol Testing Programs (NAADATP). The goal of DATIA's Nationally Accredited for Administration of Drug and Alcohol Testing Programs (NAADATP) program is to have a national standards program for companies who provide drug free workplace program management services, to ensure they have company specific standard operating procedures, safeguards, knowledge and professional practices that keep their clients in compliance with federal drug and alcohol testing regulations.

Under his leadership, in September of 1999 Florida Drug Screening was one of entities to receive funding from the United States Small Business Administration's Drug Free Workplace Program Grant. Joe's firm received this grant award again for nine years straight. Joe has personally been involved with thousands of small businesses in setting up their drug free workplace programs.

Joseph Reilly has extensive experience with drug and alcohol testing. He started a TPA for drug testing in 1993 and serviced many DOT regulated clients throughout his years in the industry.

Joe was originally trained for DOT specimen collections in 1997 and was trained as a trainer in 2001 just after the 49 CFR Part 40 overhaul.

In June of 2001 Joe attended the FTA's Public Meeting in Orlando, Florida where Ken Edgell from DOT's office of Drug and Alcohol Policy and Compliance (ODAPC) presented a full day workshop on the new Part 40 regulations. This was a comprehensive overview of the entire new 49 CFR Part 40 including all of the requirements for collectors and collector training. Joe continues to attend the FTA annual drug and alcohol testing program conference. Joe was originally trained for DOT specimen collections in 1997 and was trained as a trainer in 2001 just after the 49 CFR Part 40 overhaul in 2001.

During July, August and September of 2001, Joe developed, organized and conducted Collector Training courses throughout Florida in order to provide collector training in compliance with the new 49 CFR Part 40 regulations. These training sessions were well attended and highly rated by participant evaluations. Attendees included nurses, clinical technicians, mobile collectors, MRO's, TPA's and others in the drug/alcohol testing business. Participants also completed the mock collections required under the new Part 40 collector training requirements. Joe continues for 20+ years not to conduct specimen collector training and monitor proficiency demonstrations.

In 2003 and 2004 Joe provided contract services for Major League Baseball and Minor League Baseball providing specimen collections, specimen collection training, and specimen collection audits. In November of 2003, Joe was hired as a consultant by Wackenhut Corrections Corporation to provide in Guantanamo Bay, Cuba a drug testing program administration and collector training course for employees of Wackenhut running the Migrant Operations Center in Guantanamo Bay, Cuba. Starting in 2004, Reilly served as a Master Trainer and Regional Trainer for the Drug and Alcohol Testing Industry Association (DATIA) – Certified Professional Collector Trainer certification program.

Joe has performed thousands of urine specimen collections and breath alcohol testing and trained hundreds of individuals for to conduct DOT urine specimen collections. Joe has also performed mock audits of many collectors and many collection facilities.

In June of 2015, the national trade association for the drug testing industry (DATIA) awarded its Top Entrepreneur award to Joe Reilly of Melbourne, Florida. The Top Entrepreneur award is designed to recognize and honor the entrepreneur who has started a company and had great growth in the industry through innovation, creativity, and hard work.
